Why should I belong to the Fraternal Order of Police? 2017 FOP SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE

The Fraternal Order of Police offers scholarships to members, their immediate family and grandchildren.

Pinellas Lodge 43 Two \$1,000 awards based on an essay due by March 30, 2107.

“How shall the police and the public restore trust in one another? Single page, double spaced, 12 font. A separate page shall include the Applicant’s name, legal address, cell phone number, email address, the Lodge 43 Member they are related to and how, college attending or accepted by, and the applicant’s current enrollment.

FOP District III: Four Awards of \$500 each based on an essay due by March 01, 2017.

“Contrast the pros and cons of body camera use by law enforcement officers with reference to the Right to Privacy and Freedom of Information Act.” 1500-2000 words. Three source references, bibliography, Wikipedia is not an accepted source. Use factual date where possible. All information and requirements can be obtained from the FOP District Three website.

State FOP: One \$2,000 award per year good for four years. (2) \$1,000 one year awards, (1) \$500 one year award. Please refer to the FOP State website for criteria and other requirements.

Generally speaking there are a limited number of entrants each year so members are encouraged to provide this information to their family and grandchildren where applicable.

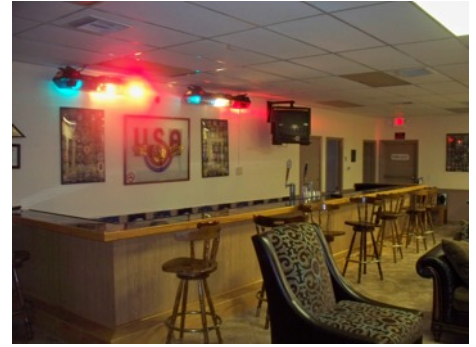
